


Kindly refer above cited letter no. SCL/BWR/ENV/2009-10 dated 15th May, 2009 seeking clarification regarding applicability of the Environment Impact Assessment Notification, 2006 for the environmental clearance for the Synthetic Gypsum Manufacturing Unit (1000 TPD) at Village Andheri Deori, Tehsil Masuda, District Admer, Rajasthan by M/s Shree Cement Ltd.

The application submitted is examined and it has been found that proposal submitted involves manufacturing of Synthetic Gypsum by mixing Limestone and Sulphuric Acid, which are inorganic activities. Since broadly only Synthetic Organic Chemical Industry is covered under EIA Notification, 2006, the Synthetic Gypsum Manufacturing Units are not covered, no environmental clearance from the Central Government is required to such plants.

However, 'No Objection Certificate', Air & Water Consents, Authorization from the Rajasthan Pollution Control Board under the provisions of the Air and Water Acts is required to be obtained.
